			<p align="center">TEAMWORK</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Allows other officials to do their jobs • Keeps line judges alert and “in the game”
			<p align="center">MECHANICS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Signals clear, crisp, correct, and held long enough for clarity • Whistle clear, sharp, authoritative and varied for different situations • Maintains even match tempo
			<p align="center">POISE</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Confident and alert • Exercises control of match without being overbearing • Has good reaction time • Follows fast net play • Overall court awareness – including benches
			<p align="center">JUDGMENT OF SETS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Uses consistent judgment from start to finish • Uses same criteria for both teams • Judges <u>non-setters</u> using same criteria as <u>setters</u>
			<p align="center">JUDGMENT OF PASSES</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Uses consistent judgment from start to finish • Uses same criteria for both teams • Does not make automatic “lift” calls on play at net
			<p align="center">OTHERS DECISIONS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Allows appropriate latitude on tips/dinks and blocks • Recognizes back row attackers and blockers • Assesses sanctions properly and fairly • Exercises common sense in unusual situations

			<p align="center">DEMEANOR</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Authoritative but not intimidating • Approachable by players and coaches • Sensitive to match environment (crowd, rivalries, close scores, etc.) • Professional – sharp uniform, on time, courteous
			<p align="center">TEAMWORK</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Assists 1st Referee with back row plays • Assists 1st Referee with ball handling when 1st Ref’s view is blocked
			<p align="center">MECHANICS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Follows 1st Ref’s signals – doesn’t “lead” • Whistle clear, sharp, authoritative • Contributes to even match tempo (administration of time outs, subs etc)
			<p align="center">RESPONSIVENESS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attentive to both benches during dead ball periods • Quickly recognizes time outs and subs • Communicates with coaches and captains without delaying game • Alert to other members of officiating crew
			<p align="center">JUDGEMENT</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Calls net fouls – <u>does not follow ball</u> • Recognizes overlaps by receiving team • Calls or assists 1st Referee with back row plays
			<p align="center">TECHNIQUE</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Focuses on defensive (blockers’) side of net • Checks receiving teams lineup on each serve • Moves quickly to substitution zone for substitutions
			<p align="center">OTHER DECISIONS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Controls entry of subs • Keeps substitutes in warm-up area • Exercises common sense in unusual situations
